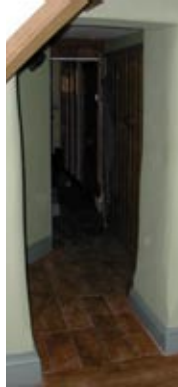


■ Project Profile: Cottage Refurbishment and Extension Upton Snodsbury

- An 18th century cottage with 19th century additions set in a Worcestershire village has formed the basis for a number of projects for the practice over the years. In all instances the overriding aim of both architects and client has been to maintain the scale and character of the original cottage whilst achieving the additional accommodations required by the client.

Extensive use has been made of reclaimed materials, including locating hand made bricks from the same local source as the original 18th century part of the cottage.

The second project, which provided a study/office space, introduced an element of green oak framing, but largely glazed to provide a light and airy space without breaking the scale of the composition.
