King's St Alban's School, Junior Library
Worcester

- The Practice was commissioned to design a new junior library for the King's St Alban's School.

The existing school is largely housed in a collection of Listed buildings within the shadow of the Cathedral. The site identified with the client was an open area over a 1960's flat roofed link containing the principal entrance between two of the historic buildings. A clumsy stair tower was situated in one corner of the space, forming the principal vertical circulation within the junior school.

Liaison with the client allowed the participation of teaching staff in the design process. Liaison with the Local Authority planning and conservation officers ensured that the striking design solution achieved approval without modification.
