- A period Victorian house in Malvern provided a challenge when asked by our clients to give their home a new lease of life.

It was important to our client that the day to day living experience paid much more attention to the garden at the rear of the house than was offered by the traditional Victorian arrangement with service rooms at the rear and living spaces on show to the road.

Opening up the existing gloomy dining room, kitchen and ancillary areas created a generous and friendly kitchen living space, complete with french doors to the garden, transforming the hub of the house flooding the space with light and giving it the desired link with the garden.

Careful re-ordering of the first floor accommodation created en suite facilities for the principal bedrooms, whilst glazed panelled doors drew light into the hallway. Retaining original features such as mouldings, balustrades etc whilst adopting a crisp contemporary decor completed the move into the 21st century.
