

■ Project Profile: Cottage Alterations and Extension Herefordshire



- Nestled in the rolling hills of the Herefordshire countryside, the internal layout of this previously extended cottage was altered, and a small extension added to better suit its owners' requirements.

The materials used in the project draw heavily from the original building and its rural context, using local stone in the walls, rough sawn timber cladding and reclaimed stone slates on the roof.

Internally, new oak joinery compliments the original structural timbers. A feature is made of one of the stone walls incorporating an original bread oven next to the fireplace.

The new extension is differentiated from the house through the use of visually lighter materials; timber cladding and large amounts of glazing.
