The students have just completed their A level exams and pieces from their end of year exhibition have been selected by David Davis, Managing Director of DJD Architects, for display at his practice.

Over 400 students started A level Art and Design at the College last year and works have been produced in Fine Art, Textiles, Graphics, Jewellery and Photography. The panels on display are creative, diverse and multi-media.
